- Please complete the PlayCAMP 2018 registration form and return it with full payment for all desired weeks!
- Full payment is due upon registration and is NOT refundable unless the camp you have registered for is full at the time of registration.
- We cannot change your registration or apply payment to alternate weeks. Registration fees apply for only the weeks selected and payment cannot be refunded.
- Campers not attending CCP must be two years old by January 1, 2018 to register. (Exceptions are currently enrolled students at the co-op.)
- Camp is for preschoolers only! Campers are not eligible to attend if they attended kindergarten during the 2017-2018 academic year.
- We do not offer financial assistance or a sibling discount for summer camps.
- Camp registrations occur on a first-come first-served basis and fill quickly. Register soon!
